# RED RIBBON & BULLYING PREVENTION WEEK

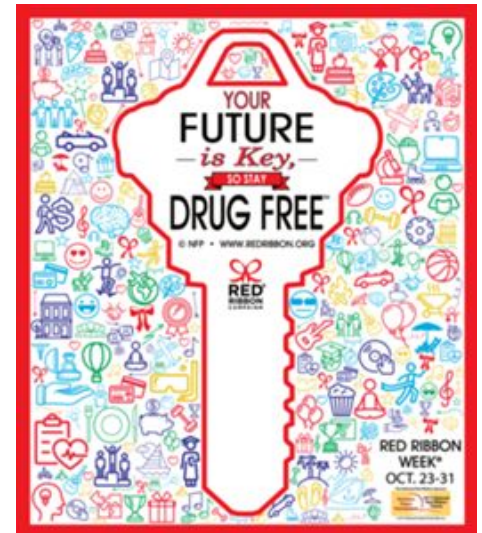
